

National Bangers Rule Update April 1st 2022

The new rule making roof plates compulsory on National Bangers has been revised. The published rule is below:-

Roof plates are compulsory. The minimum thickness of flat steel plate is 3mm, and it must be secured by a minimum of 8 bolts or welded. The roof plate must not extend further back than 75mm from the rear of the roll cage uprights.

The rule above has been superseded by the following revised rule.:-

A flat steel plate (3mm minimum) covering the sunroof (or where a manufactured sunroof would typically be) must be fitted on every national banger. It must be secured with a minimum of 8 m8 bolts and if bolted through the roll cage can not be any further back than 75mm from the cage uprights. It must not fold down the side of the roof and bolt through pillars.
